#### WEST WINCH PARISH COUNCIL MINUTES OF ANNUAL COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON 19<sup>TH</sup> MAY 2016

The above meeting was held at the Village Hall, William Burt Centre, commencing at 7.35pm

PRESENT: Cllr P Foster, Cllr P Burt, Cllr J Lamb, Cllr D Burke, Cllr B Thrower, Mrs J Close (Clerk), six residents (a further resident had left after the Annual Residents' meeting)

At the Annual Residents' Meeting (which is not minuted) the outgoing Chair had given a verbal report. He said that in June last year the PC had reported to the BC that the car park at Leete Way was untidy. To date the BC has not taken any action. The PC had successfully negotiated with Anglian Water on behalf of the Social Club and Village Hall their adoption of the sewer system. A new boiler had been installed in the football changing rooms. He remarked on the BC wanting to allow up to 6,000 houses being built in the area and how it could change the whole of West Winch. He asked that all residents do their duty to protect West Winch and oppose this mass destruction of our countryside.

### 1. ELECTION OF CHAIRMAN

It was proposed by ClIr Burt that ClIr Foster be elected as Chairman for the forthcoming year and this was seconded by ClIr Lamb. There were no other nominations and all those present were in favour of ClIr Foster being elected.

Cllr Foster duly signed the Acceptance of Office which was countersigned by the Clerk.

### 4. ELECTION OF VICE-CHAIRMAN

It was proposed by Cllr Thrower that Cllr Mrs Summers be elected as Vice Chairman for the forthcoming year and this was seconded by Cllr Foster. There were no other nominations and all those present were in favour of Cllr Mrs Summers being elected.

### 5. CO-OPTION OF RESIDENTS TO VACANT COUNCILLOR SEATS

The Clerk reported that although three vacancies remained on the Parish Council no-one had come forward to volunteer their services.

### 6. SIGNING OF THE ACCEPTANCE OF OFFICE OF VICE-CHAIRMAN

The Vice-Chairman was unable to attend the meeting due to personal reasons. The signing of the Acceptance of Office would be carried out at the next available meeting.

### 13. ACCOUNTS & FINANCE

The Clerk explained the statement of accounts for year ending 31<sup>st</sup> March 2016 and that the accounts had been to internal audit and had been found in order and duly signed by the auditor. Cllr Lamb proposed that the accounts and annual governance statement be approved for the previous year and Cllr Burt seconded with everyone in favour. The paperwork was duly signed by the Chairman and Clerk. These accounts will now be sent to the external auditor, Mazars. The Chairman commented on the fact that the Parish Council had spent 105.84% of the budgeted expenditure figure and had received in income of 123.32% of budget. Part of the additional income was because the Social Club had paid one invoice twice.
